(If you plan on voting for your ATA Delegate and ATA Alternate Delegate, please renew your ATA membership prior to the State Shoot). **CSTA members who qualify will be given a ballot at registration.**

### GENERAL SHOOT RULES

- Purses and options are not compulsory.
  - Shooting starts promptly at the time indicated and only the starting squads will be called. Please watch the "ON DECK" signs.
  - Classification will be based upon generally accepted ATA procedures and all decisions of the classification committee are final. ***Please have your average card up to date with your averages calculated.***
  - Squad Changes: There is a \$10.00 change fee for any squad changes made after 3:00 pm the previous day.
  - Please attend the meeting for all Colorado Trap Shooters after the 1st 100 singles on Saturday, June 20, 2020 at Noon to elect the ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate. The Colorado State Team awards will also be presented.
  - Please attend the 2020 Hall of Fame ceremony and induction during Friday Night, June 19th.
  - ALL EVENTS WILL BE SHOT 5 TARGETS PER POST, 50 PER TRAP (Shoot management reserves the right to modify this format.)
  - Ties for events A, C, 1 & 3 (Singles & Doubles) will be carried over to the next like event.
  - Handicap ties will be determined by CSTA officials at the end of each day of shooting. If you do not report for shootoffs within the allotted time, you will forfeit. No exceptions to this rule.
  - The CSTA reserves the right to alter or modify the program and to reject anyone who, in our opinion is detrimental to the shoot.
  - It is the responsibility of money winners to report their winning to the IRS. Please feel free to provide your SSN to the cashier during registration to expedite any payoffs you may have coming.
  - Board of Directors meeting: Friday June 19, 2020 - 6:30pm at PPGC Clubhouse
  - Practice traps will be open at 7:30 AM daily and available up to first flight of shooters - Approximately 9:30AM. Will also be available between events as time allows and the conclusion; ALL daily events contingent on shootoffs. Practice fields are the upper trap fields directly in front of clubhouse. Can be modified at anytime per the discretion of PPGC Trap Committee. All 14 traps will be used during all events. Practice rounds will be \$6.00 per 25 targets.
  - Added money is open to all shooters entered in the event.
  - Entrants for husband/wife (Domestic Partners) or two in a family (immediate family such as parent or siblings) in Event 5 must declare prior to the start of the event. You can win only one category.
- (1) It is the responsibility of all special category shooters to ensure they are placed in the correct category at the time they are classified/handicapped. If your special category does not appear on the bulletin sheet, report the omission at the cashier's.
  - (2) **Class Advance:** High Score in each class in Events 1 & 3 will be advanced for all like events. Class advancements will apply independently to in-state and out-of-state classes. PAID OPTIONS FOLLOW SHOOTER TO ADVANCED CLASS
  - (3) **100 or 200 Straight Pins:** Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight without carryover will be awarded a 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any one individual.
  - (4) There will be no co-winners/champions. Ties must be settled for trophies purposes and All American Points.
  - (5) **Credit cards** accepted with a 3% charge for all **targets, options and purses** (Visa, MasterCard, Amex, Discover)

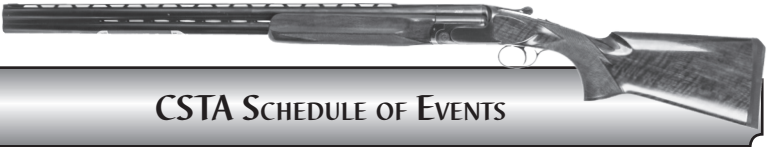
### SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
2. A female shooter, who had reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th Birthday, may declare Sub-Junior.
4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th Birthday may declare as Junior.
5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd Birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th Birthday may declare as a Sub-Veteran.
7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th Birthday may declare as a Veteran.
8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.
9. Age based categories are established on the Birthday of the shooter. For purposes of determining age category for HOA and HAA awards the category declared by the participant of the first day he/she shoots shall be used.
10. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example a shooter reaching age 70 may elect to continue to shoot as a Veteran for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year. Note: Age based special category shooters that are in contention for or desire to achieve All-American Team recognition should review the All-American Team policy in the ATA Rule Book. When there is no Sub-Junior trophy Sub-Juniors will be included in the Junior category. Senior Veterans will be included in the Veteran category when there is no Senior Veteran trophy.

**PETS:** Shooters are required to have their pets leashed at all times while on the grounds. It is also mandatory that you clean up after your pet. Owners will be held liable/responsible for their animals.

**ATVs AND GOLF CARTS:** Use of personal ATVs and golf carts is allowed. Owner must have liability insurance.

## CLASSIFICATION

### Classification Will be Based on the Higher of:

- Last Year's Average
- This Year's Average
- The Last 500 Targets
- Known Ability

Any shooter who has registered less than 500 16-yard, 1,000 Handicap, and 300 Doubles for the current year and previous two (2) years will be required to shoot penalty yardage and classification, unless current classification or yardage exceeds penalty. Penalty classification and yardage will be:

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter at any time during the shoot.

## 2020 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

### ***Congratulations to Colorado State Trap Shooting Association's 2020 Hall of Fame Inductee.***

#### **Paul Dible**

Paul Dible has been shooting ATA registered targets since 2004. At the end of 2019, Paul had recorded 31,800 singles targets, 27,200 handicap targets and 23,900 doubles targets. His average for singles was 97.25, he had an average of 90.4 for handicap, 92.82 for doubles and an overall average of 93.49. He was classified as an AAA-27-AA shooter.

Paul has shot 50 plus 100 straights in singles, two 200 straights in singles and one 100 straight in doubles. He made the 27 yard line in June of 2008 at the Family Shooting Center in Cherry Creek State Park and received his AA-27-AA ATA pin in 2014. In 2011 Paul won a Gold medal in Trap from the Colorado State Police and Fire Games. In 2019 he was the Colorado State PITA Singles Champion and was the CSTA Doubles Champion. His wife is proud to be able to say she is shooting in the Dible Doubles for 2020. Paul first made the CSTA State Team in 2008 and has been on the team every year since.

Trap Ladies and Gentlemen

We spend some of our best moments creating memories and skills shooting registered targets and competing with each other. An opportunity to share these joys with others due to changes in the tax code has arisen.

With the increase in the standard deduction to \$24,000 for married filing joint and \$22 million estate equivalency, the CSTA and/or your club have been put on the same level as a 501(c)(3) or church in that neither gets an income tax or estate deduction unless donors exceed those limits.

Here is how it works:

If your estate exceeds \$22 million, you might as well gift money to organizations you like (like the Martins do) otherwise the government will take away 50% and spend it foolishly...

If you have an estate less than \$22 million, you still have to dispose of it somehow, so you might as well gift to the CSTA or your club to share your joys and memories with your friends. That gift can be a specific bequest in your will or trust or your CSTA/club could be named as a life insurance beneficiary. You could also specify that any memorials from your funeral be made to the CSTA/club.

Likewise, if you do not have \$24,000 in itemized deductions there is no charitable tax benefit, so you could include the CSTA/club in your gifting program.

If this makes sense to you, you can get this done with an update of your will, by including as beneficiary on a life insurance policy, or by telling your prospective executor where to donate memorials. Get it done now because it gets tougher to do as we age or accidents or illnesses happen.

Historically, people give because they want to, not because it is deductible. We just have to ask.
