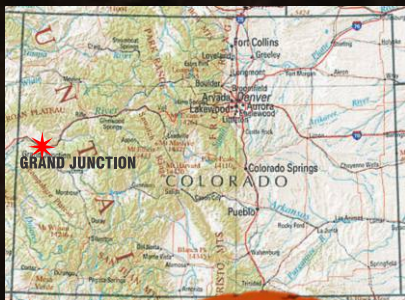

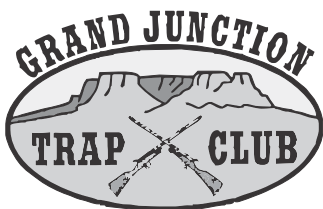

T. A. and member in good standing of the Colorado State Trapshooting Association. A candidate for election must evidence membership in good standing for at least 5 consecutive years, active participation of at least 500 targets (Singles, Handicap and Doubles combined) in current and previous 4 years with at least 3,000 targets total in current and previous year. Target participation may be waived for shooters with an extensive target history who, because of documented physical problems, are not currently able to participate. A candidate must have not been suspended for any reason from the A. T. A.

NOTE: Only those **CSTA Members** with a **CSTA 2025** membership card and **in possession of a current paid average card** issued by the ATA can vote. (If you plan on voting for your ATA Delegate and ATA Alternate Delegate, please renew your ATA membership prior to the State shoot). **CSTA members who qualify will be given a ballot at registration**

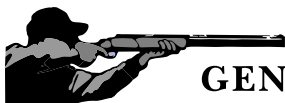

GENERAL SHOOT RULES

- Purses and options are not compulsory.
 - Shooting starts promptly at the time indicated and only the starting squads will be called. Please watch the "ON DECK" signs.
 - Classification will be based upon generally accepted ATA procedures and all decisions of the classification committee are final. ***Please have your average card up to date with your averages calculated.***
 - Squad Changes: There is a \$10.00 change fee for any squad changes made after 3:00 pm on the previous day.
 - *Please attend the meeting for all Colorado Trap Shooters after the 1st 100 singles on Sat., June 14, 2025 to elect the ATA Delegate and Alternate Delegate. The Colorado State Team awards will also be presented.*
 - Please attend the 2025 Hall of Fame ceremony and induction - Friday night, June 13th.
 - ALL EVENTS WILL BE SHOT 5 TARGETS PER POST, 50 PER TRAP. (Shoot management reserves the right to modify this format)
 - Ties for events 1 & 3 (Singles & Doubles) will be carried over to the next like event.
 - Handicap ties will be determined by shoot off at the end of the day of shooting. If you do not report for shoot-offs within the allotted time, you will forfeit. No exceptions to this rule.
 - The CSTA reserves the right to alter or modify this program and to reject anyone who, in our opinion would be detrimental to the shoot.
 - It will be the responsibility of money winners to report their winnings to the IRS.
 - **Board of Directors Meeting: Friday, June 13, 2025 - Location TBD**
 - Practice traps will be open at 7:00 a.m. daily to 8:00 a.m. approximately as our events will commence at 8:30 a.m. Practice rounds will be \$7.00 per 25 targets.
 - Added money is open to all shooters entered in the event..
 - Entrants for husband/wife and two in a family (immediate family such as parent or siblings) in Event #5 must declare prior to the start of the event. You can win only one category.
- (1) It is the responsibility of all special category shooters to see that they are so marked at the time they are classified/handicapped. If your special category does not appear on the bulletin sheet, report the omission at the cashier's.
- (2) **100 or 200 Straight Pins:** Shooters breaking 100 or 200 straight without carryover will be awarded a 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any one individual.
- (3) There will be no co-winners/champions. Ties must be settled for trophy purposes and All American Points.
- (4) **Credit Cards** accepted with a 3% charge for all targets, options and purses.



GENERAL INFORMATION

SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

All eight special categories (listed below) must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
2. A female shooter, who has reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th Birthday, may declare Sub-Junior.
4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th Birthday may declare as Junior.
5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd Birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th Birthday may declare as a Sub-Veteran.
7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th Birthday may declare as a Veteran.
8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.
9. Age based categories are established on the Birthday of the shooter. For purposes of determining age category for HOA and HAA awards the category declared by the participant of the first day he/she shoots shall be used.
10. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example a shooter reaching age 70 may elect to continue to shoot as a Veteran for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. Junior shooters reaching the age of 18 may continue to declare Junior category for the remainder of the current target year. Note: Age based special category shooters that are in contention for or desire to achieve All-American Team recognition should review the All-American Team policy in the ATA Rule Book. When there is no Sub-Junior trophy Sub-Juniors will be included in the Junior category. Senior Veterans will be included in the Veteran category when there is no Senior Veteran trophy.

PRE-SQUADDING: Pre-squadding will be used and available on the Website at www.SOSpresquad.com beginning April 1, 2025 and ending June 1, 2025 at 10 pm. The cost is \$2.00 per event. Log on and have your ATA Card and credit card available for payment and other information asked for. As you log on you will note other instructions to follow. All pre-squadding on SOSpresquad.com must be done by "CREDIT CARD" only. Pre-squadding ends on June 13, 2025. If not using pre-squad.com, you can still squad at time of arrival. NO OTHER FORMS OF PRE-SQUADDING WILL BE USED.

ATVs AND GOLF CARTS: Use of personal ATVs and golf carts is allowed. Owner must have liability insurance.



PETS: Shooters are required to have their pets leashed at all times while on the grounds. It is also mandatory that you clean up after your pet. Owners will be held liable/responsible for their animals.

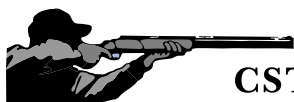

****New CSTA Classifications Change****

- * Shooters with less than 500 singles or doubles targets in the current target year will be advanced 1 class or more based on their ATA history and known ability.
- * Shooters with less than 500 handicap targets in the current target year will be classified at a minimum of 25 yards or higher if their assigned ATA yardage is longer than 25 yards.
- * Penalty classification shall be waived for Senior Veteran and Lady II shooters.

The Handicap Committee reserves the right to reclassify any shooter at any time during the shoot.

The A.T.A. rules will govern all points that are not otherwise provided. If you win your class or any event or earn yardage in any handicap, it is your responsibility to report such change to the Committee.

Appropriate hearing and eye protection will be worn by all personnel on the firing line; this includes employees who perform duties on or near the trap field.

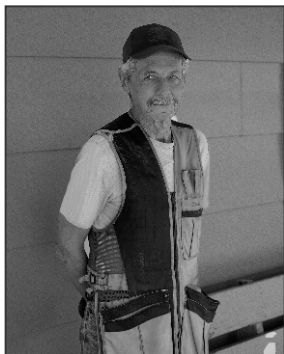

**BRAD WELLINGTON**

Brad Wellington began his journey in trapshooting in 1972, attending his first registered ATA shoot in Steamboat Springs, Colorado. Since then, he has dedicated over four decades to the sport, with his shooting career spanning more than 40 years, despite taking a break from 1992 to 2000.

As of the 2024 target year, Brad has registered an impressive 43,850 singles, 46,500 handicap, and 32,200 doubles targets. He has achieved the esteemed AA-27-AA classification and has recorded multiple high scores, including several 199s in singles, 99s in both handicap and doubles, and numerous perfect 100 straights. His lifetime averages stand at 93.82 in singles, 87.90 in handicap, and 87.12 in doubles.

Brad has competed at 12 different clubs across Colorado some of which are no longer active as well as at clubs in Utah, Wyoming, Arizona, North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia and New Mexico. He is a long-time member of the Delta Trap Club and has served for many years as the CSTA delegate for Delta. Beyond his personal accomplishments, Brad has made a lasting impact on the sport by mentoring many young and new shooters, helping them develop their skills and passion for trapshooting.

In recognition of his dedication and contributions to the sport, Brad will be inducted into the Colorado State Trapshooting Association Hall of Fame on June 13, 2025.

**MIKE PETERSON**

Mike began shooting at Pikes Peak Gun Club in 2006. From the beginning, Mike was a fixture as a volunteer both at Pikes Peak Gun Club and at the state level. He began his volunteering career as a youth coach for the Pikes Peak Claybusters in 2008 and even had the chance to help bring home their first national trophy from the 2008 Grand American. Mike continued to coach for a few more years before he stepped up as the Colorado AIM Director in 2014. He continues to hold that office today.

It is no secret that Mike has given many volunteer hours to furthering youth shooting in the state of Colorado, he volunteers anywhere he is needed. He has been a board member at Pikes Peak Gun Club since 2008, held the Treasurer position from 2021-2022, and was elected as President in 2022 and continues to serve as such. During his 14-year tenure on the PPGC board of directors, Mike has been the Trap Chairman from 2010-2019.
